T	<i>Tristaniaopsis laurina</i>	Little-leaf Myrtle, AKA water gum	L	Many individuals survive off irrigation as street trees in SB. SMG says occasionally to regularly, other sources confirm drought tolerance and need of 1x weekly or less summertime water and no winter water
T	<i>Washingtonia filifera</i>	California fan palm	L	As per Pittenger et al 2009, SB experience- can survive off irrigation easily in Santa Barbara; common street tree.
