SUBJECT: Potential for Carshare Pilot Project

Recommendation:

That the Downtown Parking Committee find a potential carshare partnership between a private company and the City of Santa Barbara to be consistent with the Circulation Element of the General Plan.

Discussion:

Over the last several months staff has researched carshare practices in other California cities (Santa Monica, Los Angeles, Pasadena, West Hollywood, Berkeley, San Francisco, Sacramento) and has found growing popularity for both carsharing and Transportation Network Companies (TNC's, like Lyft or Uber). Members of carshare organizations are finding greater convenience, lower driving costs, and in many cases decreasing need for automobile ownership are possible while maintaining access to cars when they are needed. Similarly, TNC's are providing an on-demand service for a reduced cost which results in added convenience and reduced reliance on automobile ownership. Lastly, municipalities and their residents are benefiting from more transportation options, lower automobile ownership rates, and fewer vehicle miles traveled.

Staff believes that carsharing is a viable option for Santa Barbara's residents and that instituting carsharing in downtown Santa Barbara would promote the General Plan's Circulation Element goals and policies:

Goal – Integrated Multimodal Transportation System. Create a more integrated multimodal transportation system to connect people, places, goods and services. Provide a choice of transportation modes and decrease vehicle traffic congestion.

Policy C1.2 – Personal Transportation. In partnership with private interests, promote and provide incentives including the provision of funding, for shared-cost personal transportation options such as carsharing and bikesharing to increase personal mobility, reduce air pollution and greenhouse gas emissions, reduce parking demand, and decrease the cost of transportation to individuals.

On September 11, 2014, representatives of Zipcar came to Santa Barbara to discuss the potential for their company to begin providing carshare services in the downtown. Zipcar is already providing cars for their members at UCSB and at the Santa Barbara Airport and expressed a keen interest in partnering with the City to bring approximately 10 cars into several downtown locations. Since being acquired by Avis Budget Group Inc. in 2013, Zipcar has continued to grow its membership and now has superior flexibility in quantity and rapidity of fleet deployment. In other words, Zipcar feels they could bring 10 cars into Santa Barbara very quickly and easily adjust the fleet up or down depending on demand.

Other benefits as reported by the Transportation Research Board/National Academy of Sciences and Zipcar surveys include:

- Each Zipcar takes 15 personally owned vehicles off the road.
- Members report a 46% increase in transit usage.
- Zipcar members drive 40% fewer miles on average (annually after becoming members).
- Members report saving \$500+ dollars per year (versus car ownership).

Next Steps:

A draft carshare ordinance that enables partnership with a qualified bidder to designate parking for shared vehicles has been prepared and would need to be adopted by City Council in the coming months. A Request For Proposals or a Request For Qualifications would then likely be released in order to determine which carshare company would be selected to partner with the City.


