The City Council is considering a Charter Amendment to be placed on the November 2009 ballot. The amendment would be related to the heights of buildings allowed in the C-2, C-M and M-1 commercial and industrial zones of the City where 60-feet in height is currently allowed. The ABR, HLC and Planning Commission will discuss design and land use issues associated with reducing the heights from 60-feet to 45-feet in commercial zones with some exceptions for affordable housing projects, rental housing and community priority uses. The discussion will include a variable front yard setback to allow for landscaping along with a companion zoning ordinance.

The C-2, C-M and M-1 zones are generally located in the downtown area between the waterfront on the south, Padre Street to the north, the 101 Freeway on the west, and the Milpas Street corridor on the east, as well as an area near Constance and Chapala Streets.

You are invited to attend these meetings and address your verbal comments. Written comments are welcome.
