Summary of Council Actions
July 17 through October 9, 2007

1. Council adopted, by reading of title only, ordinance no. 5422 approving a ten-year lease with one ten-year option between the City of Santa Barbara and the County of Santa Barbara at the Franklin Neighborhood Center.
2. Council authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute the following lease agreements for space at the Westside Community Center: Santa Barbara Center for the Performing Arts and Special Olympics of Southern California.
3. Council found it in the City's best interest to approve Icon Shelter Systems as the supplier for a prefabricated architectural art element for the Bohnett Park Expansion Project, without bids, as authorized by Municipal Code Section 4.52.080 (k); and authorized the General Services Manager to award a purchase order contract to RecWest in the amount of \$95,900.
4. Council appropriated \$33,531 in expenditures and \$61,000 in revenues to the Parks and Recreation Department Miscellaneous Grants Fund for the Field Scheduling Program budget.
5. Council interviewed and appointed applicant Christina Gonzalez for the position of Youth Intern on the Park and Recreation Commission.
6. Council endorsed a City of Santa Barbara Youth, Education, and Families Platform; and adopt, by reading of title only, Resolution 07-068 in Support of the City Platform of the National League of Cities' Council on Youth, Education, and Families for Strengthening Families and Improving Outcomes for Children and Youth.
7. Council increased estimated revenues and appropriations in the Fiscal Year 2008 Miscellaneous Grants Fund for the Parks and Recreation Department in the amount of \$7,500 for the 2007 Salsa Festival.
8. Council accepted a grant from the State of California Parks and Recreation Department in the amount of \$181,000 for the Leadbetter Utilities Project.
9. Council authorize the Parks and Recreation Director to enter into three agreements with the Santa Barbara School Districts (SBSD) for Afterschool Opportunities for Kids (A-OK!), Recreation Afterschool Program (RAP), and the Junior High Afterschool Sports and Recreation Program; Appropriated 487,692 in expenditures and \$345,307 in revenues to the Parks and Recreation Department Fiscal Year 2008 Miscellaneous Fund budget for afterschool programs and field scheduling and monitoring; and adopted, by reading of title only, A Resolution of the Council of the City of Santa Barbara Amending Resolution No. 07-053, the Position and Salary Control Resolution for Fiscal Year 2008, Affecting the Recreation Division of the Parks and Recreation Department Effective September 18, 2007.
10. Council increased appropriations and estimated revenues by \$57,000 in the Fiscal Year 2008 Parks and Recreation Capital Budget for the Tennis Lighting Controls project based on an accepted Proposition 12 Per Capita Grant Program Application by the California Department of Parks and Recreation.

11. Council adopted, by reading of title only, A Resolution of the Council of the City of Santa Barbara in Support of the Institute for Local Government Communities for Healthy Kids (CHK) Program.
12. Council increased appropriations and estimated revenues in the Parks and Recreation Capital Fund by \$25,000 based on receiving a \$50,000 Proposition 12 Per Capita Grant from the California Department of Parks and Recreation.
13. Council authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute a lease agreement for space at Franklin Neighborhood Center with Project Excel/University of California Santa Barbara (UCSB).
