3. Subject: Street Tree Advisory Committee Recommendations – For Action (Attachment)

Recommendation: That the Commission:

A. Deny the following Street Tree removal requests:

1. 554 Alan Rd. – *Liquidambar styraciflua*, American Sweetgum – Jeff Ruppert

The Committee (3/0) recommends that the Commission deny the removal. The Committee determined the seed pods could be reasonably cleaned up.

2. 48 Chase Dr. – (2) *Pyrus kawakamii*, Evergreen Pear – Bryan Van Derhyden

The Committee (3/0) recommends that the Commission deny the removals. The Committee determined that the reasons supplied by the applicant are insufficient to justify removal. The applicant has also submitted a request to change the designated tree for this block at a future meeting. The Committee commented that if this request is successful the applicant could plant the new designated tree between the existing trees and re-apply for removal of the Evergreen Pears after the new trees have developed sufficient canopy.
