The Single Family Design Board (SFDB) will hold a public hearing to give the public an opportunity to be heard and offer comments early in the review process on architectural design related issues or development plan approval findings regarding the subject property below:

Project Description: **Proposal for additions and alterations to an existing one-story 2,088 square foot single-family residence, located on a 13,796 square foot lot in the Hillside Design District. The proposal includes the conversion of the existing 459 square foot attached garage to a habitable addition and 125 square feet of new additions. The application is requesting a parking exception to provide one-covered and one-uncovered parking space and involves the construction of a new one-car carport and new permeable paving. Additional site alterations include new site walls and patios, deck additions, alterations to an existing deck, the demolition of an existing concrete patio, and demolition of an 'as-built' storage structure. The proposed total of 2,967 square feet is 70% of the maximum floor-to-lot area ratio (FAR). The project includes Staff Hearing Officer review for requested zoning modifications.**

Public comments will be allowed during review of the project by the SFDB. The SFDB is a body appointed by the City Council to focus on neighborhood compatibility, aesthetics, and design issues. Comments on private views and privacy issues are only partially within the SFDB's authority. Due to time constraints, individual comments may be limited to two minutes. Written comments are also welcome up to the time of the hearing, and should be addressed to the City Planning Division, P.O.
